

**Dr. Dinshah K Mehta**



*"Accept what is acceptable but do not reject what is not acceptable"* and

*"Plan not but fit into the Divine Plan"* are two important principles advocated by Dr. Dinshah K. Mehta.

In order to fit into the Divine Plan, one has to transition from the way of life in which one is, into the Divine Plan for one's soul. The Dr. Dinshah K Mehta Spiritual Centre of the **Society of Servants of God** can help you explore these possibilities.

### The Society of Servants of God (SSG)

On November 8, 1953, after 17 years of inner struggle, **Dr. Dinshah K Mehta** finally accepted the instructions by God to establish the Society of Servants of God – SSG as a Charitable Trust and register it with the office of the Charity Commissioner in Bombay. Thus, the Society of Servants of God was registered in the month of August 1955.

The Society of Servants of God has been given the following three missions:

- To help people realize the Divine Self within
- To introduce and propagate spiritual values in all walks of material life including politics, economics, law, and education.
- To bring about unity in the diversity of religions

Under the first mission, which is spiritual, the focus is to help people grow to know the Divine within; while the second mission focuses on introducing spiritual values in activities dealing with matter and so is a material mission while the third mission, which is religious, aims to bring about the common spiritual basis of all religions.


The SSG has branches in the USA and also devotees and associated organizations in Canada and Germany.

### Dr. Dinshah K Mehta – A truly unique personality

Born on June 5th 1903 in Bombay, Dr. Dinshah K Mehta's maternal family was from Jalna and he spent his youth between Bombay and Jalna.



At around the age of 5, Dr Mehta wondered what the purpose of life is. He concluded that perfection is the purpose of life. So he developed a perfect physique and was requested to public display of his body, by posing on stage, as statues of world-renowned Greek sculptures. He was also requested to perform several feats of strength. To help harassed local villagers, he would hunt wild animals.




He, later, pioneered Naturopathy as a system of medicine, having renowned political personalities among his patients including Mahatma Gandhi, Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, Mohammad Ali Jinnah, Rajkumari Amrit Kaur, Jawaharlal Nehru, Sir Stafford and Lady Cripps, among many more.

His contribution to India's freedom struggle has not been published in history books, but his behind-the-scenes role as a liaison between Mahatma Gandhi and Mohammad Ali Jinnah, the Muslim League, and Sir Stafford Cripps, helped achieve independence for India under the Congress Party.



Dr Mehta's experiences in the spiritual realm were spontaneous and fraught with struggle as he resisted the experiences of inner hearing (Shruti) and inner visions (Smriti) because he was skeptical of these experiences, until much later, when he surrendered to the Divine, after he received a spiritual sign that he demanded which convinced him that it was indeed God who was behind the spiritual experiences.



### The National Institute Of Naturopathy – the pioneering spirit of Dr Mehta

As a young man, Dinshah experimented with and developed various methods of natural healing and established the Nature Cure Clinic and Sanatorium in Pooona. He also had a clinic and Naturopathy hospital in Bombay. Mahatma Gandhi heard about Dr Mehta's success stories using various systems of natural healing and recommended his line of treatment to people in need.

Later, Mahatma Gandhi himself became Dr. Mehta's patient and made his home in Dr. Mehta's Poona institution. Several meetings of the All India Congress Committee were held there. As mentioned earlier, many of India's political leaders too, were Dr. Mehta's patients.






### Dr Dinshah K Mehta Spiritual Centre - SSG


